Pingzhen Logistics Center

The Pingzhen Logistics Center spans over 27,000 ping (89,256 sqm) and houses several warehouses, including A, B, C, E, F, G, and Warehouse 10. Warehouse E is leased to Eslite Spectrum Corporation, Warehouse F to HAVI Logistics (Taiwan) Co., Ltd., and Warehouse 10 to CTW Logistics Corporation.


Nankan Logistics Center

Covering an area of more than 16,000 ping (52,892 sqm), the entire plant is currently leased to Hong Kong-based Scandinavian Health Limited (SHL). SHL is a company engaged in manufacturing pharmaceuticals and medical materials.



Covering an area of more than 2,000 ping (6,611 sqm), the warehouse is currently a professional logistics warehouse primarily focused on the storage of raw herbal medicine materials.

Early Stage of Lily's Logistics Development






